

### GOOD MORNING to our Members and Guests:

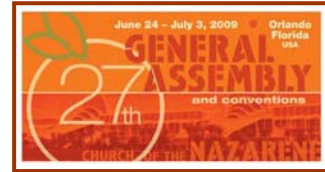

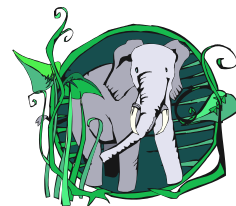
